- Record Career Options from left to right.

- Record Career Satisfaction Factors (CSF) from top to bottom.

- Rank each career option against each CSF on a scale of 1 to 10. The score of 10 indicates that this factor is fully expressed while working in this career and the 1 indicates that this factor is totally absent. Then, calculate the vertical sum of CSF for each career option.
